EXPLANATORY NOTE

The role of the Barangay in our society is crucial as they are the basic unit where the primary planning and implementation of government programs are effected. A microcosm of the government, which by itself is authorized to enact laws, enforce them, as well as exercise judicial functions in its katarungang pambarangay duties – the barangay officials are on-call 24/7 for the welfare of its constituency. Their political jurisdiction maybe small, but their duties are expansive and calls for direct assimilation among members of the community.

The provision in the Local Government Code enumerating the benefits and privileges for these barangays officials leave much to be desired. If we are to effectively give to the local government units the self-sufficiency that the government envisions, we must be able to provide the conditions conducive to a productive leadership.

This bill proposes to fill-in the inequities in the present law by providing for the increase in their honorarium and Christmas bonuses and granting an additional benefit of a lump sum gratuity pay upon their retirement – the much needed benefit and privilege to our hard-working barangays officials.

Approval of this bill is earnestly sought.

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Section 393 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 393. Benefits of Barangay Officials.

- (a) Barangay officials, including barangay tanods and members of the lupong tagapamayapa, shall receive honoraria, allowances, and such other emoluments as may be authorized by law or barangay, municipal or city ordinance in accordance with the provisions of this Code, but in no case shall it be less than [One]**FIVE** thousand pesos (P[1] 5,000.00) per month for the

(1) Be entitled to Christmas bonus of at least [One] TWO thousand pesos (P[1] 2,000.00) each, the funds for which shall be taken from the general fund of the barangay or from such other funds appropriated by the national government for the purpose[;]: PROVIDED, THAT BARANGAY HOWEVER, **TANODS** MEMBERS OF THE LUPONG TAGAPAMAYAPA SHALL ALSO ENJOY THIS BENEFIT.

(2) Be entitled, during their incumbency, to insurance coverage which shall include, but shall not be limited to temporary and permanent disability, double indemnity, accident insurance, death and burial benefits, in accordance with Republic Act Numbered Sixty-nine hundred forty-two (R.A. No. 6942), entitled "An Act Increasing the Insurance Benefits of Local Government Officials and Providing Funds Therefor;"

(3) Be entitled to free medical care, including subsistence, medicines, and medical assistance in any government hospital or institution: Provided, That such hospital care shall include surgery or surgical expenses, medicines, X-rays, laboratory fees, and other hospital expenses;

In case of extreme urgency where there is no

In case of extreme urgency where there is no available government hospital or institution, the barangay official concerned may submit himself for immediate attendance to the nearest private clinic, hospital or institution and the expenses not exceeding Five thousand pesos (P5,000.00) that may be incurred therein shall be chargeable against the funds of the barangay concerned;

(4) Be exempted, during their incumbency, from paying tuition and matriculation fees for their legitimate dependent children attending state college or universities. He may likewise avail of such educational benefits in a state college or university located within the province or city to which the barangay belongs; [and]

(5) Be entitled to appropriate civil service eligibility on the basis of the number of years of service to the barangay, pursuant to the rules and regulations issued by the Civil Service Commission[.];

(6) BE ENTITLED TO A LUMP SUM RETIREMENT GRATUITY PAY EQUIVALENT TO ONE (1) YEAR HONORARIUM TO BE TAKEN FROM THE BARANGAY RETIREMENT GRATUITY FUND: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT A RETIREE IS AT LEAST SIXTY (60) YEARS OF AGE WITH A MINIMUM OF NINE (9) YEARS IN SERVICE AT THE TIME OF THE RETIREMENT;

29	administer and ensure the appropriate disbursement of the Fund.

31	SEC. 3. Coverage The benefits granted under this Act shall cover all
32	barangay officials, barangay tanods and members of the lupon ng tagapamayapa,
33	including those in the Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (ARMM);

35	SEC. 4. Rules and Regulation The Department of Budget and
36	Management (DBM), in coordination with the DILG and Department of

Transportation and Communications (DOTC), shall issue the necessary rules and
 regulation to implement this Act.

SEC. 5. *Repealing Clause.* – All laws, executive orders, issuances, rules and regulations inconsistent with this Act are hereby amended, repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 6. *Effectivity.* - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
