AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE FOR SOCIAL WELFARE ATTACHÉ, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8042, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE MIGRANT WORKERS AND OVERSEAS FILIPINOS ACT OF 1995, AS AMENDED, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. Section 2, paragraph (b) of Republic Act No. 8042, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - "(b) The State shall afford full protection to labor, local and overseas, organized and unorganized, and promote full employment and equality of employment opportunities for all. Towards this end, the State shall provide adequate and timely social, economic and legal services to Filipino Migrant Workers, ESPECIALLY SINCE THESE WORKERS ARE VULNERABLE TO EXTREME PHYSICAL, EMOTIONAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL STRESS."
- 9 SEC 2. A new paragraph (e) is hereby inserted in Section 23 of Republic Act 10 No. 8042, as amended, to read as follows:
- "(E) DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT THE 11 DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT SHALL DEPLOY 12 SOCIAL WELFARE ATTACHÉS TO MANAGE CASES OF OVERSEAS FILIPINO 13 WORKERS NEEDING PSYCHOSOCIAL SERVICES AND OVERSEAS FILIPINOS 14 IN DISTRESS, SUCH AS VICTIMS OF TRAFFICKING, ILLEGAL RECRUITMENT, 15 16 SEXUALLY-ABUSED. MALTREATED/MISTREATED **OVERSEAS** FILIPINOS, ABANDONED/NEGLECTED CHILDREN AND VULNERABLE SECTORS IN 17 COORDINATION WITH THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNTRY TEAM AND PREPARE 18 SOCIAL WELFARE SITUATIONER OF OVERSEAS FILIPINOS IN THE POST." 19

- SEC 3. Interpretation in favor of the welfare of overseas Filipino workers, their families and trafficking victims. In the interpretation of any provision of this Act or any rules or regulations issued as a result thereof, the interpretation, which is most favorable to ensure the welfare of overseas Filipino workers, their families and trafficking victims shall be controlling. Furthermore, nothing in this Act shall be interpreted to diminish any right or privilege currently being enjoyed or provided to OFWs, their families and victims of trafficking.
- **SEC 4.** Funding. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act shall be provided for in the General Appropriations Act of the year following its enactment into law and thereafter.
- SEC 5. Implementing Rules and Regulations. The Department of Social Welfare and Development, in consultation with the Department of Foreign Affairs, Department of Labor and Employment, Department of Health, Philippine Overseas Employment Administration, Overseas Workers Welfare Administration, Commission on Filipino Overseas and other relevant stakeholders, shall formulate and issue the implementing rules and regulations for this Act within sixty (60) days after the effectivity of this Act. The Department of Social Welfare and Development shall also provide the criteria for determining the selection of Diplomatic Posts to which Social Welfare Attaches will be deployed and the minimum qualifications and attributes of the Social Welfare Attachés.
- **SEC 6.** Separability Clause. If, for any reason, any section or provision of this bill is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other sections or provisions hereof shall remain in force.
- **SEC 7.** Repealing Clause. All laws, decrees, executive orders, rules, regulations or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
- SEC 8. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen days after publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
